Scholarship for Children of the Membership Requirements

1. The *SBEA Scholarship for Children of the Membership* is a one-time scholarship.
2. Nominees must be the child of an SBEA member in good standing.
3. Nominees must be graduating high school seniors who are accepted at or who have applied for entrance to a:
 - a. Two-year college,
 - b. Four-year college,
 - c. Nursing school, and/or
 - d. Technical training school.
4. The winner must have been accepted into one of the above mentioned types of schools in order to receive the scholarship.
5. Applications are to be submitted to a designated SBEA representative. This person will number code all entries so students remain anonymous to the judges.
6. The Scholarship Committee will meet each year to determine the topic of the essay (written statement).
7. Scholarship forms will be made available to SBEA building reps by the May Rep Council meeting.
8. The completed scholarship forms are due to be returned by the June Rep Council meeting.

Applications will be judged by a committee consisting of one SBEA member each from the high school, middle school, and elementary school level. If volunteers from each level are not able to be obtained, representation will be balanced as best as possible at the discretion of the Scholarship Chair. The scholarships will be mailed to the winner(s) during the summer, or they may be delivered to the SBEA member in September.

NOTE: This scholarship may vary from year to year and is not guaranteed to be awarded. The actual number of scholarships and the amount to be awarded will be determined each year based on donations to the SBEA Philanthropic Fund.
